FALL FEATHERFEST 2025 - SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Entry Deadline

Entry deadline is Friday, October 9, 2025. **NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DATE.**

2. Charge Fees

Entry fees <u>MUST</u> accompany entry. Cheques shall be payable to VPPC, mailed to Heather Hayes, 5019 Lansdowne Rd., Armstrong BC, V0E 1B4

Entry Fees for poultry, waterfowl & pigeon are as follows:

Adults - \$7.00 exhibitor fee, \$3.50/bird. Juniors - \$7.00 exhibitor fee, \$2.50/bird. (Junior is 18 years and under.)

3. Coop-In

The show site will be open to receive birds from noon until 8:00 pm Friday, October 17. All birds must be cooped by 8:00 am, Saturday Oct. 18.

4. Disclaimer

The Club will not be responsible for loss, injury, death, disease, safety or the well-being of exhibitors' entries.

5. Bird Health

The Show Committee reserves the right to reject birds suffering from disease, or showing evidence of poor health, and also to request their removal from the building.

6. Interference

Once judging begins, no one except bird carriers and show officials will be allowed in the judging area. Any exhibitor interfering with the judging or attempting to influence the judge will have his/her entry disqualified.

7. Ownership

All birds shown must be owned not less than 30 days by the exhibitor.

8. Judging

Judging of birds to start at 8:00 A.M. Judge's decision will be final.

9. Band Numbers

Pigeon Band numbers must be stated on entry form. All pigeons must wear seamless legbands. Poultry and waterfowl should have numbered identification bands, but these are not mandatory.

10. Substitutes

Substitutions are allowed within same breed and class. Changes **must be given** to Show Secretary before birds are cooped.

11. Coop-Out

Birds are not to be taken from the show area until coop-out Sunday morning. Out of town birds, (e.g. Calgary, Vancouver, and Prince George) may be taken out earlier with permission of Show Conveners and after judging is complete.

12. Refunds

Money will NOT be refunded for exhibits entered in show and not shown.

13. Awards

All exhibitors are asked to be present on Saturday for presentation of awards. Those unable to attend the awards presentation will be able to pick up their awards on Sunday morning at coop-out.
